B. The youth apprenticeship program for pharmacy technicians and pharmacy technician training programs through the Oklahoma

Department of Career and Technology Education shall carry liability insurance on the students in the respective program that covers the student anywhere the student is training in a pharmacy.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
