10 An Act relating to higher education; creating the
11 Making College More Affordable Act; prohibiting
12 research universities from requiring in-state
13 students purchase a meal plan as condition for
14 enrollment or residing on campus; providing for
15 noncodification; providing for codification;
16 providing an effective date; and declaring an
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
20 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

21 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Making College
22 More Affordable Act".

23 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.7-2 of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 Research universities within The Oklahoma State System of Higher
2 Education shall not require any in-state student to purchase a meal
3 plan as a condition:

- 4 1. Of enrollment; or
- 5 2. For residing in on-campus housing.

6 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

7 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
