11	An Act relating to professions and occupations; creating the assistant funeral director license;
12	establishing license application requirements; creating license procedures; amending 59 O.S. 2021,
13	Section 396, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 32, O.S.L. 2023 (59 O.S. Supp. 2024, Section 396),
14	<pre>modifying sunset date; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an</pre>
15	emergency.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 396.3b of Title 59, unless there
20	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. The term "assistant funeral director" as herein used means a
22	person who assists a duly Oklahoma licensed funeral director in one
23	or more of the principal functions of funeral directing, and is
24	actively engaged in such work. An assistant funeral director shall

be an employee of the funeral director-in-charge under whom the employee is registered, and shall be a person to whom the funeral director-in-charge delegates the responsibility of conducting funeral services, making funeral arrangements, and making interments.

6 в. The Oklahoma Funeral Board may, in its discretion, license 7 assistant funeral directors to each Oklahoma-licensed funeral director-in-charge. The funeral director-in-charge shall have only 8 9 one assistant funeral director. Licensure as an assistant funeral 10 director shall be separate and distinct from registration as an 11 apprentice funeral director and/or embalmer. The Board may issue an 12 assistant funeral director license on successful completion of the 13 Oklahoma Funeral Board Law examination, the manner and form of which 14 is to be determined by the Board, and upon the payment of the 15 application fee which shall include the license fee for the current 16 year or portion thereof, and such application and registration and 17 renewal fee shall be in the amount fixed by the Board in accordance 18 with the provision of Section 396.4 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma 19 Statutes. Before issuing a license to an applicant for an assistant 20 funeral director's license, the Board shall require satisfactory 21 proof that the applicant is capable and trustworthy to act as such 22 and that the applicant is a person of good moral character, has a 23 good standing in the community and is qualified to engage in the 24 business. In determining the moral character of any such applicant,

1 the Board shall take into consideration any felony conviction of 2 such person, but such conviction shall not automatically operate as a bar to licensure. Each person applying for an assistant funeral 3 4 director's license shall make application and be recommended in 5 writing on forms provided by the Board. The application shall show that the applicant is at least eighteen (18) years of age and shall 6 7 have at least sixty (60) semester hours of study earned, measured in quarter or clock hours, from a regionally accredited college or 8 9 university before such license can be issued to the applicant. Upon 10 issuing a license to an assistant funeral director, as herein 11 provided, the Board shall cause the licensee to be registered under 12 the supervision of the Oklahoma-licensed funeral director by whom 13 such licensee is employed and under whom such licensee is 14 registered. The funeral director under whom the assistant funeral 15 director has been registered must immediately notify the Board when 16 the licensee has left the director's employ. Upon the re-employment 17 of the licensee by any other funeral director-in-charge, such 18 licensee shall be reinstated by the Board. The work of an assistant funeral director shall at all times be under the supervision and 19 20 control of the Oklahoma licensed funeral director under whom the 21 licensee is registered. Licenses of assistant funeral directors may 22 be suspended or revoked, or the Board may refuse to issue or renew 23 the same, for any of the reasons and in the manner stated herein for 24 funeral directors' licenses.

C. The expiration date of each license shall be December 31. Subject to the provisions of this section, each license shall be renewable on an annual basis upon the filing of a renewal application prior to the expiration date of the license and upon payment of the renewal fee.

D. The assistant funeral director shall complete continuing
education in accordance with the provision of Section 396.5b of
Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 396, as
10 amended by Section 1, Chapter 32, O.S.L. 2023 (59 O.S. Supp. 2024,
11 Section 396), is amended to read as follows:

12 Section 396. There is hereby re-created, to continue until July 13 1, 2024 2029, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma 14 Sunset Law, the Oklahoma Funeral Board. Any reference in the 15 statutes to the Oklahoma State Board of Embalmers and Funeral 16 Directors shall be a reference to the Oklahoma Funeral Board. The 17 Board shall consist of seven (7) persons, who shall be appointed by 18 the Governor. The term of membership of each member of the Board 19 shall be five (5) years from the expiration of the term of the 20 member succeeded. Any member having served as a member of the Board 21 shall be eligible for reappointment. Provided that, a member of the 22 Board shall serve no more than two consecutive terms and any 23 unexpired term that a member is appointed to shall not apply to this 24 limit. The Governor shall appoint the necessary members to the

1 Board upon vacancies and immediately prior to the expiration of the 2 various terms. Upon request of the Governor, appointments of a licensed embalmer and funeral director member of the Board shall be 3 4 made from a list of five qualified persons submitted by the Oklahoma 5 Funeral Directors Association. An appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the unexpired term. A member of the Board shall serve 6 7 until a successor is appointed and qualified. No person shall be a member of the Board, unless, at the time of appointment, the person 8 9 is of good moral character and a resident of this state. Five of 10 the members shall have been actively engaged in the practice of 11 embalming and funeral directing in this state for not less than 12 seven (7) consecutive years immediately prior to the appointment of 13 the person, shall have an active license as provided by the Funeral 14 Services Licensing Act, shall keep the license effective, and remain 15 a resident of this state during the entire time the person serves on 16 Two of the members of the Board shall be chosen from the the Board. 17 general public, one of whom shall, if possible, be a person licensed 18 and actively engaged in the health care field, and shall not be 19 licensed funeral directors or embalmers or have any interest, 20 directly or indirectly, in any funeral establishment or any business 21 dealing in funeral services, supplies or equipment. These two 22 members shall be appointed to serve for five-year terms. 23 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
