11	An Act relating to agriculture; authorizing
12	advertisement of certain products; amending 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, which relates to the Oklahoma
13	Milk and Milk Products Act; adding donkey milk to certain exceptions; modifying construing provisions;
14	providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7-422 of Title 2, unless there
20	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	Any person who engages in the on-farm sale of donkey milk may
22	advertise such donkey milk.
23	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2021, Section 7-414, is
24	amended to read as follows:

1	Section 7-414. A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Milk and Milk
2	Products Act shall not be construed to:
3	1. Include incidental sales of raw milk directly to consumers
4	at the farm where the milk is produced;
5	2. Preclude the advertising of the incidental sale of goat milk
6	or donkey milk; and
7	3. Prohibit any farmer or producer from making cheese using
8	milk or cream produced on the farm of such farmer or producer.
9	B. For purposes of this section, incidental sales of goat milk
10	or donkey milk are those sales where the average monthly number of
11	gallons sold does not exceed one hundred (100).
12	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
