17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
18	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 2401,
19	is amended to read as follows:
20	Section 2401. Sections $4 2401$ through $10 2407$ of this
21	act <u>title</u> shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
22	State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Act.".
23	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 2402,
24	is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 2402. A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma 2 State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Program. The 3 purpose of the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising 4 Scholars Award Program is to retain top-ranked students from 5 Oklahoma in Oklahoma colleges, enable Oklahoma institutions 6 of higher education to compete aggressively for top Oklahoma 7 scholars, attract high-caliber out-of-state students to Oklahoma to attend colleges and universities, and enhance the 8 9 academic quality in Oklahoma colleges and universities. The 10 program shall provide participants funding for enrollment 11 fees, tuition and other fees, room and board and required 12 textbooks or materials for up to five (5) years of 13 undergraduate and/or graduate study at accredited 14 institutions of higher education in Oklahoma. 15 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall Β. 16 administer the provisions of the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic 17 Rising Scholars Award Program. 18 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 2403, is 19 amended to read as follows: 20 Section 2403. A. No person shall be eligible to participate in 21 the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Program 22 unless the person: 23 1. Has complied with all of the rules promulgated by the

24 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the

1 provisions of the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars 2 Award Act, Section 2401 et seq. of this title, for the award, regulation, and administration of scholarships; and 3 4 2. Qualifies as one of the following: 5 a. an Individual Applicant Qualified Student, which shall mean a student who is a resident of the State of 6 7 Oklahoma whose American College Testing Program score or whose Scholastic Aptitude Test score falls within 8 9 the 99.5 to 100.0 percentile levels as administered in 10 the State of Oklahoma and whose grade point average 11 and/or class rank is exceptional, as determined by the 12 State Regents, 13 b. a Presidential Scholar, which shall mean a student 14 selected by the Commission on Presidential Scholars 15 administered by the United States Department of 16 Education, 17 a National Merit Scholar, which shall mean a student с. 18 designated as a National Merit Scholar by the National 19 Merit Scholarship Corporation, 20 d. a National Merit Finalist, which shall mean a student 21 designated as a National Merit Finalist by the 22 National Merit Scholarship Corporation, or 23 24

1	e.	after October 1, 1999, an Institutional Nominee, which
2		shall mean a student nominated by an institution in
3		The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education:
4		(1) whose American College Testing Program or
5		Scholastic Aptitude Test score falls within the
6		95.0 to 99.49 percentile levels, or
7		(2) who shows exceptional academic achievement as
8		evidenced by factors, including, but not limited
9		to, grade point average, class rank, national
10		awards, scholastic achievements, honors, and who
11		shows exceptional promise based on documentation
12		that may include, but not be limited to, teacher
13		recommendations, extracurricular activities, and
14		evidence of overcoming economic and social
15		obstacles as determined by the State Regents.
16		The State Regents shall ensure that standards of
17		high academic ability are documented.
18		Scholarship awards to Institutional Nominees
19		shall become effective when appropriate
20		documentation is verified by the State Regents.
21	B. No per	rson shall be eligible to receive a scholarship
22	pursuant to th	ne provisions of the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic
23	Rising Schola	rs <u>Award</u> Program unless the person is enrolled as a
24		

1 full-time student at a public or private accredited institution of 2 higher education in Oklahoma.

C. The For a student who qualifies pursuant to subparagraphs a 3 4 through d of paragraph 2 of subsection A of this section and subject 5 to the availability of funds, the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic 6 Rising Scholars Award Program shall provide a scholarship in an 7 amount not to exceed the average costs of all enrollment fees, 8 tuition and other fees, room and board, and all required textbooks 9 or materials for up to five (5) years of undergraduate and/or 10 graduate study at an accredited public or private institution of 11 higher education in Oklahoma as provided in subsection E of this 12 section. The State Regents may establish separate scholarship award 13 levels for each qualifying category.

14 <u>1. If the student is attending an institution within The</u>
Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the total funding for the
scholarship provided in this subsection, exclusive of any
internships, shall not exceed the costs for items specified in this
subsection at the institution attended as determined annually by the
Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
20 <u>2. If the student is attending a private institution of higher</u>

education, the total funding for the scholarship provided in this subsection, exclusive of any internships, shall not exceed the costs for items specified in this subsection at an institution of The

24 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education of comparable type which

1	has the highest general enrollment fees of its type of institution
2	in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education as determined
3	annually by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
4	D. For a student who qualifies pursuant to subparagraph e of
5	paragraph 2 of subsection A of this section and subject to the
6	availability of funds, the Oklahoma Rising Scholars Award Program
7	shall provide a scholarship in an amount not to exceed the average
8	costs of all enrollment fees and other fees, room and board, and all
9	required textbooks or materials for up to five (5) years of
10	undergraduate and/or graduate study at an accredited public or
11	private institution of higher education in Oklahoma. The State
12	Regents may establish separate scholarship award levels for each
13	qualifying category.
14	1. If the student is attending an institution within The
15	Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the institution shall
16	provide a tuition waiver not to exceed the average cost of tuition.
17	The total funding for the scholarship and waiver provided for
18	students attending an institution within The Oklahoma State System
19	of Higher Education as provided in this subsection, exclusive of any
20	internships, shall not exceed the costs for items specified in this
21	subsection at the institution attended as determined annually by the
22	Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
23	2. If the student is attending a private institution of higher

24 education in Oklahoma, the scholarship shall include an amount not

1 to exceed the average cost of tuition. The total funding for 2 scholarships for students attending a private institution as provided in this subsection, exclusive of any internships, shall not 3 4 exceed the costs for items specified in this subsection at an 5 institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education of comparable type which has the highest general enrollment fees of its 6 7 type of institution in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education as determined annually by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher 8 9 Education. 10 E. If a person identifies himself or herself as a student with 11 a disability and requests consideration for a scholarship under the 12 Academic Oklahoma Rising Scholars Program Award by means other than 13 standard testing procedures, the State Regents shall determine what 14 means of assessment are appropriate and upon the basis of said 15 assessment results, determine what level of award, if any, shall be 16 made. 17 E. 1. If the student is attending an institution of The 18 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the total funding for the 19 scholarship provided in this section, exclusive of any internships,

20 shall not exceed the costs for items specified in subsection C of

21 | this section at the institution attended as determined annually by

22 the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

23 2. If the student is attending a private institution of higher
 24 education, the total funding for the scholarship provided in this

1 section, exclusive of any internships, shall not exceed the costs 2 for items specified in subsection C of this section at an 3 institution of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education of 4 comparable type which has the highest general enrollment fees of its 5 type institution in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education as determined annually by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher 6 7 Education. 70 O.S. 2021, Section 2404, is SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 8 9 amended to read as follows: 10 Section 2404. A. Scholarships awarded under the Oklahoma State 11 Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Program shall be awarded to 12 all eligible applicants without any limitation on the number of 13 scholarships to be awarded in any year other than the amount of 14 funds available for the scholarship program and the number of 15 eligible applicants.

16 The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education may, at the Β. 17 time a scholarship is awarded to a student, set aside in the 18 Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Trust Fund 19 funds for the full five-year commitment made to such eligible 20 scholar. For all academic years, students who have previously 21 received academic scholarships under the provisions of this act and 22 who have continued at all times to fulfill the requirements for 23 eligibility to receive academic scholarships provided in this act 24 shall be given an absolute priority for continued financial support

by the Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award
 Program superior to any students who are applying for such academic
 scholarships awards for the first time.

4 С. In addition to the qualifications specified in Section 2403 5 of this title, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education may adopt additional criteria for selection and allocation of awards 6 7 which may include, but are not limited to, consideration of high school academic performance and personal interviews. The Oklahoma 8 9 State Regents for Higher Education shall annually report on the 10 number of former Academic Rising Scholars Award Program participants 11 who stay in state as compared to those who leave Oklahoma within 12 five (5) years of leaving the Award Program. In addition, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are hereby authorized to 13 14 determine a maximum number of awards or a maximum amount of funding 15 which may go to nonresident students. Such maximum limitations 16 shall not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the awards or amount 17 of funding in any category provided in paragraph 2 of subsection A 18 of Section 2403 of this title.

19SECTION 5.AMENDATORY70 O.S. 2021, Section 2405, is20amended to read as follows:

21 Section 2405. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education 22 may adopt rules and regulations, prescribe and provide appropriate 23 forms for application, and employ such persons, contract for such 24 services and make such additional expenditures as may be necessary

1 or appropriate for implementing the provisions of the Oklahoma State 2 Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Act; provided, as part of the regulations adopted for administration of the provisions of the 3 4 Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Program, the 5 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall require that each 6 scholarship recipient make continuing and satisfactory progress 7 toward a degree, including the establishment of an annual minimum 8 grade point average and annual minimum credit hours to be maintained 9 by the participants. Such regulations shall also provide for 10 revoking or rescinding assistance to any scholarship recipient who 11 fails to meet such required standards. Such regulations shall also 12 provide that the funds made available to students as part of the 13 Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Program shall 14 be paid directly to the institution of the student's choice, in 15 trust for the student, and on the student's behalf, and shall 16 contain appropriate restrictions and conditions that such monies are 17 expended only for the purposes authorized by this act. Such 18 regulations shall also provide for portability of award for a 19 recipient among accredited institutions of higher education in 20 Oklahoma in which the recipient may enroll as long as the recipient 21 meets requirements of the program; however, waivers shall only be 22 portable between institutions in The Oklahoma State System of Higher 23 Education and waiver portability may be further limited by the 24 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education rules and regulations.

1SECTION 6.AMENDATORY70 O.S. 2021, Section 2406, is2amended to read as follows:

3 Section 2406. The Oklahoma State Regents' Academic <u>Rising</u> 4 Scholars <u>Award</u> Act shall not be construed as granting any authority 5 to control or influence the policies of any educational institution 6 because it accepts students who are participating in the scholarship 7 program, or to require any such institution to admit, or once 8 admitted to continue in such institution, any participant in the 9 scholarship program.

10 SECTION 7. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 2407, is 11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 2407. As part of its duties in administering the 13 Oklahoma State Regents' Academic Rising Scholars Award Program, the 14 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, in cooperation with the 15 State Board of Education, shall encourage Oklahoma high school 16 juniors who plan to attend college to take the Preliminary 17 Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test 18 in their junior year in high school as preparation for taking the 19 Scholastic Aptitude Test their senior year in high school. 20 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. 21 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
