15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6224 of Title 36, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	Under any method of compensation, the total commission payable
19	to the public insurance adjuster, including expenses, direct costs,
20	or any other costs accrued by the public insurance adjuster, shall
21	not exceed ten percent (10%) of the amount of the insurance
22	settlement when adjusting for entities subject to The Governmental
23	Tort Claims Act, Section 151 et seq. of Title 51 of the Oklahoma
24	Statutes.
