NEW LAW 20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4810 of Title 36, unless there 21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 22 In rural fire departments, fire insurance policies shall provide 23 coverage in all residential or dwelling policies for a fire 24 department response at a minimum of two percent (2%) of the property

The fire department response fee shall be One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) for the first hour and Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for each additional quarter hour. The cost to replace Class A firefighting foam used to extinguish a fire may be added to the fire department response fee. This rate shall be reviewed annually by the Insurance Commissioner of the Oklahoma Insurance Department, and any increase amounts will be determined by either the Consumer Price Index or an alternative index the Commissioner deems appropriate. For purposes of this section, "consumer price index" means the consumer price index for all urban consumers as determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics within the United States Department of Labor. SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6093 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: In rural fire departments, coverage for a fire department response to a motor vehicle accident shall be provided under the liability coverage policy. The coverage shall be for a fire department response at a rate of Five Hundred Forty Dollars
