15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L6	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 180.14 of Title 17, unless there

18	The Oklahoma Corporation Commission is hereby required to
L9	prepare and submit an annual report detailing all activities and

23	1. A detailed account of all trips taken by Commission

3	2. A record of all meetings attended by Commission
4	representatives with the Southwest Power Pool or its

8	representatives on matters related to the Southwest Power Pool,
9	including the nature and outcomes of such votes.
10	The report shall cover all relevant activities undertaken during
11	the preceding calendar year and shall be completed and submitted no
12	later than January 31 of each year to the Speaker of the Oklahoma
13	House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the
14	Oklahoma State Senate.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
