| 20 | Section 1097. A. As used in this section, "unauthorized camp" |
| 21 | means any tent, shelter, or bedding constructed or arranged for the |
| 22 | purpose of or in such a way to permit overnight use on a property |
| 23 | not designated as a campsite. |

| 3 | C. Any person who violates the provisions of this section |

| 6 | county jail not to exceed fifteen (15) days, or by both such fine |
| 7 | and imprisonment. However, a person who commits a first violation |
