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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:							
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified							
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1239 of Title 69, unless there							
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:							
19	A. As used in this section, the term "invasive woody species"							
20	means a tree or shrub species that is rapidly encroaching into							
21	adjoining lands and is likely to cause harm to the environment or							
22	economy. Invasive woody species include, but are not limited to,							
23	Juniperus virginiana (Eastern Redcedar), Juniperus scopulorum (Rocky							
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1	Mountain	juniper),	Juniperus	monosperma	(oneseed	juniper)	and
2	Tamarix	ramosissima	a (salt ce	dar).			

- B. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation shall establish and implement a program for the systematic identification, removal, and management of invasive woody species within rights-of-way under its jurisdiction. The eradication program shall include the following components:
- Surveys to identify the presence and extent of invasive woody species;
- 2. Development of a prioritized plan for eradication and control;
- 3. Use of best management practices for removal, including methods that minimize harm to native vegetation and prevent soil erosion:
  - 4. Monitoring and follow-up measures to prevent reestablishment; and
- 5. Collaboration with local, state, and federal agencies, as well as nongovernmental organizations, to leverage expertise and resources.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
