

1 3. "Qualified nonprofit agency for the employment of people
2 with significant disabilities" means a nonprofit agency employing
3 persons with significant disabilities who ~~constitute~~ work at least
4 ~~seventy five percent (75%)~~ fifty percent (50%) of the direct labor
5 hours engaged in direct production, manufacturing, processing and/or
6 assembling of products or services offered by the agency for
7 procurement by this state ~~or who meet the definition of blind person~~
8 ~~as provided for in paragraph 1 of this section,~~ or which is
9 certified as a sheltered workshop by the Wage and Hour Division of
10 the United States Department of Labor;

11 4. "Person with significant disabilities" means an individual
12 with a physical or mental disability constituting a substantial
13 handicap to employment and preventing the person from engaging in
14 normal competitive employment ~~and/or includes any,~~ a blind person,
15 as defined in paragraph 1 of this section, or an individual with
16 intellectual disability or developmental disability, as defined in
17 Section 1408 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

18 5. "Qualified organization" means a blind person or qualified
19 nonprofit agency for the employment of people with significant
20 disabilities contracting to supply goods or services;

21 6. "Manufactured" means goods made by manual labor;

22 7. "Produced" means to have brought into existence or created
23 from raw materials;

1 8. "Processed" means the action of taking something through an
2 established and mostly routine set of procedures or steps to
3 substantially convert a potential product from one form to another.
4 This action involves a sequence of multiple steps each requiring a
5 distinct decision-making process to evolve a potential product to
6 the next step;

7 9. "Assemble" means to put or fit together or put together the
8 parts of a potential product;

9 10. "Central nonprofit agency (CNA)" means a qualified 501(c)3
10 nonprofit entity meeting the qualifications in the Request for
11 Procurement (RFP) issued by the Office of Management and Enterprise
12 Services selected to administer and oversee the State Use Program;
13 and

14 11. "Procurement schedule" means a designated schedule of
15 products and services currently approved by the Office of Management
16 and Enterprise Services Central Purchasing Division as suitable to
17 procure from qualified organizations participating in the State Use
18 Program.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
