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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2021, Section 405.4, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 405.4. A. Any person with a bachelor's degree or
19	postgraduate degree shall be considered as having met the
20	educational requirements for a director of a full-time child care
21	center required by the Department of Human Services. Nothing in
22	this section shall be construed as to affect annual continuing
23	education requirements. The director of a child care center may
24	also qualify as a master teacher for children of all ages.

B. <u>1.</u> Any person replacing a master teacher at a child care
center shall be granted a one-year probationary period to fulfill
the educational qualifications required by the Department for a
master teacher. The Department may extend the probationary period
an additional year as long as the person is actively pursuing that
goal.

7 <u>2. Directors shall have sixty (60) days to appoint a</u> 8 probationary master teacher.

9 C. Licensed child care facilities opened or expanded before 10 November 1, 2016, shall have thirty-five (35) square feet of floor 11 area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants. New construction 12 and existing space not previously licensed for child care after 13 November 1, 2016, shall have forty (40) square feet of floor area 14 per infant in rooms occupied only by infants.

D. In determining the number of master teachers required based
 on license capacity and desired Star level, after school care
 children shall not be counted toward the license capacity.
 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
