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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6170.1 of Title 36, unless there
18	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
19	As used in this act:
20	1. "Community benefit expenditure" means an expenditure for an
21	activity or program or to an organization that seeks to achieve the
22	objectives of improving access to dental services and enhancing
23	dental public health. This includes an activity that:
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1 is available broadly to the public and serves low-2 income consumers, reduces geographic, financial, or cultural barriers to 3 b. accessing dental services, and if the activity ceased 4 5 to exist would result in reduced access, addresses oral health workforce shortages, such as 6 C. advancing the education and training of oral health 7 8 professionals, or 9 d. leverages or enhances dental public health activities; provided, community benefit expenditure shall not include any 10 expenses incurred for promotion, advertisement, or marketing by a 11 12 dental insurer: 2. "Dental coverage plan" means a health coverage plan that 13 includes coverage for the costs of dental care services and provides 14 coverage to employees and individuals; 15 3. "Dental loss ratio" means, for employer coverage issued by a 16 dental coverage plan, the ratio of incurred claims and other 17 compensation paid or due to providers, as defined in Section 6142 of 18 Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes, provided under a dental carrier 19 contract issued in this state, including, but not limited to: 20 a. related state and federal taxes, 21 b. related licensing and regulatory fee expenses, 22

nonprofit community benefit expenditures that have

been disclosed to the public to support dental

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1 services and improve dental care access and quality in 2 this state, the amounts or related payments identified through 3 d. fraud reduction efforts, and 4 5 any other related payments pursuant to state or federal law, 6 7 excluding the reporting period; 4. "Large employer" means an employer who employed at least 8 9 fifty-one employees on business days during the preceding calendar year and who employs at least one employee on the first day of the 10 11 plan year; and 12 5. "Small employer" means an employer who employed between one and fifty employees on business days during the preceding calendar 13 year and who employs at least one employee on the first day of the 14 15 plan year. SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6170.2 of Title 36, unless there 17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 On or before June 30, 2027, and on or before June 30 each 19 year thereafter, a dental carrier that issues, sells, renews, or 20 offers a dental coverage plan shall file with the Insurance 21 Commissioner a report that includes the dental loss ratio for the 22

preceding calendar year reported by market segment. The initial

report shall include dental loss ratios for the calendar years of

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1	2024, 2025, and 2026. A dental carrier shall file the report in the
2	format or on forms determined by the Commissioner.
3	B. The Commissioner shall annually post all submitted reports
4	on a dedicated link or page on the Commissioner's website on or
5	before September 15 of each year.
6	C. The Insurance Department shall evaluate the effectiveness of
7	informing the public on the dental loss ratio information reported
8	and make recommendations, if applicable, on the continuation or
9	modification of the obligation of dental carriers to report such
10	information.
11	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
