12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 61 O.S. 2021, Section 227, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 227. A. 1. This act shall not apply to:
15	a. highway construction,
16	b. railroad construction, <del>or</del>
17	c. turnpike construction, or
18	d. municipal road construction.
19	2. Except as the following may be a portion of a construction
20	contract as defined in Section $\frac{2}{2}$ 222 of this act <u>title</u> , this act
21	shall not apply to:
22	a. roads,
23	b. bridges,
24	c. utilities,

- d. traffic control,
- e. drainage construction,
- 3 f. sanitary sewer construction, or
- 4 g. waterline construction.

5 3. This act shall not apply to any contract relating to a6 single-, two-, three-, or four-family dwelling.

7 B. The following are against the public policy of this state8 and are void and unenforceable:

9 1. A provision, covenant, clause or understanding in,
10 collateral to or affecting a construction contract that makes the
11 contract subject to the laws of another state or that requires any
12 litigation, arbitration or other dispute resolution proceeding
13 arising from the contract to be conducted in another state; and

14 2. A provision, covenant, clause or understanding in,
15 collateral to or affecting a construction contract that disallows or
16 alters the rights of any prime contractor, subcontractor, sub17 subcontractor, or material supplier to receive and enforce any and
18 all rights under this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
