17	time an entire community or neighborhood, or any considerable number
18	of persons, although the extent of the annoyance or damage inflicted
19	upon the individuals may be unequal. The manufacturing, marketing,
20	and selling of lawful products shall not be deemed a public
21	nuisance.
22	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2021, Section 8, is
23	amended to read as follows:
24	Section 8. <u>A.</u> The remedies against a public nuisance are:

5	B. To be found liable in an action for public nuisance, the

7	been in control of the conditions giving rise to the nuisance at the
8	time of injury.
9	SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2021, Section 10, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	Section 10. A private person may maintain an action for a
12	public nuisance if $\frac{1}{10}$ the court determines by clear and convincing
13	evidence that the nuisance is specially injurious the proximate
14	cause of special injury to himself the private person, but not
15	otherwise.
16	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
