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9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
10	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6060.3b of Title 36, unless
12	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
13	A. As used in this section:
14	1. "Contraceptive drugs" means all drugs approved by the United
15	States Food and Drug Administration that are used to prevent
16	pregnancy including but not limited to hormonal drugs administered
17	orally, transdermally, and intravaginally; and
18	2. "Health benefit plan" means a health benefit plan as defined
19	pursuant to Section 6060.4 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
20	B. Any health benefit plan that is offered, issued, or renewed
21	on or after the effective date of this act that offers coverage for
22	contraceptive drugs shall provide coverage for an enrollee to
23	obtain:

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1	1. A three-month supply of a contraceptive drug at once the
2	first time the enrollee obtains the drug; and
3	2. A twelve-month supply of the contraceptive drug at once each
4	subsequent time that the enrollee obtains the same drug, regardless
5	of whether the enrollee was enrolled in the health benefit plan the
6	first time that the enrollee obtained the drug.
7	An enrollee may obtain only one twelve-month supply of a covered
8	prescription drug during each twelve-month period.
9	C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit an
LO	enrollee of a health benefit plan from requesting a smaller supply
1	or to prohibit a prescribing provider from prescribing a smaller
L2	supply if such a prescription is supported by clinical utility and
L3	medical appropriateness.
L 4	D. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require
L5	coverage under a health benefit plan for any medications that could
16	be used to terminate an existing pregnancy.
L7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
