L3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L 4	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L 5	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-180 of Title 70, unless there
L 6	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L7	A. The State Department of Education shall establish and
L 8	maintain the Oklahoma High Dosage Tutoring Program.
L 9	B. For the purposes of this section, "cohort" means a student
20	or group of students of no more than four (4) who receive subject-
21	specific high dosage tutoring in mathematics or reading in at least
22	three thirty-minute sessions each school week throughout a semester
23	by an individual employed or contracted as a high dosage tutor by a

public school district participating in the program.

C. High dosage tutors employed or contracted by public school districts participating in the Oklahoma High Dosage Tutoring Program shall be awarded bonuses in the following amounts:

- 1. One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$1,600.00) for each cohort educated by a high dosage tutor per semester; and
- 2. One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each academic grade level increase in English language arts or mathematics that each student within a cohort experiences within one academic year.
- D. If a high dosage tutor fails to achieve one-half grade level of growth in students within a cohort within the first year of participating in the program, he or she shall have one year of probation as a participant in the program. If the high dosage tutor fails to achieve one-half grade level of growth within a cohort while on probation, he or she shall lose eligibility to participate in the program.
- E. The State Board of Education may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-180.1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the "High Dosage Tutoring Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of

1 all monies received by the State Department of Education from gifts, grants, donations, bequests, federal funds provided for the purpose 2 of funding high dosage tutoring, or state appropriations provided 3 for the purpose of implementing the provisions of Section 1 of this 4 5 act. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State 6 Department of Education for the purpose provided for in this 7 section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants 9 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 10 Services for approval and payment. 11 12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025. SECTION 4.
