13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2021, Section 14-110, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 14-110. When a municipality has compiled and published
17	its permanent volume or biennial supplement of penal ordinances, the
18	governing body of the municipality shall adopt a resolution
19	notifying the public of the publication. A copy of the resolution
20	shall be filed in the office of the county clerk in each county in
21	which the municipality is located. The county clerk shall assign
22	the filed resolution a book and page number. At least one copy of
23	the permanent volume and each biennial supplement shall be deposited
24	free of cost by the municipality in the county law library of each

1	county wherein the municipality is located, and receipt of same
2	shall be duly noted in writing by the county law librarian. A copy
3	of the receipt may be filed with the county clerk who shall then
4	assign a book and page number. The permanent volume or biennial
5	supplement of compiled penal ordinances shall be available for
6	purchase by the public at a reasonable price. Ordinances which have
7	been compiled and filed in accordance with this section shall be
8	judicially noticed in all court proceedings. Provided, a court may
9	consider a book and page reference of the county clerk's filings as
10	satisfactory proof of compliance so that judicial notice may be
11	taken of an ordinance.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
