8	An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2021, Section 13-116, which relates to use of corporal
9	punishment on certain students; prohibiting use of corporal punishment on any student identified with
10	certain disability; removing language authorizing certain waiver; providing an effective date; and
11	declaring an emergency.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 13-116, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 13-116. A. School district personnel shall be
18	prohibited from using corporal punishment on students any student
19	identified with the most significant cognitive disabilities
20	according to criteria established by the State Department of
21	Education unless addressed in an annual individualized education
22	program (IEP) developed a disability in accordance with the
23	Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

1	B. A waiver to the provisions of subsection A of this section
2	shall be granted if the parent or legal guardian of a student
3	provides written consent.
4	C. As used in this section, "corporal punishment" means the
5	deliberate infliction of physical pain by hitting, paddling,
6	spanking, slapping, or any other physical force used as a means of
7	discipline.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.
9	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
11	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
