11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 804, as
12	amended by Section 28, Chapter 310, O.S.L. 2023 (47 O.S. Supp. 2024,
13	Section 804), is amended to read as follows:
14	Section 804. A. No person shall act as an instructor unless
15	such person applies for and obtains from Service Oklahoma a license
16	in the manner and form prescribed by Service Oklahoma.
17	B. Rules promulgated by Service Oklahoma, in conjunction with
18	the Department of Public Safety, shall state the requirements for an
19	instructor's license, including requirements concerning moral
20	character, physical condition, knowledge of the courses of
21	instruction, motor vehicle laws and safety principles and practices,
22	previous personnel and employment records, and such other matters as
23	Service Oklahoma, in conjunction with the Department of Public
24	Safety, may prescribe for the protection of the public.

1	C. Rules promulgated by Service Oklahoma under the provisions
2	of subsection B of this section shall require an applicant for the
3	license to have three (3) years of verifiable commercial driving
4	experience within ten (10) years of the application date or three
5	(3) years of verifiable experience as an instructor at a commercial
6	driver training school within ten (10) years of the application
7	date.
8	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
