10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 15 O.S. 2021, Section 754, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 754. Nothing in the Oklahoma Consumer Protection Act
14	shall apply to:
15	1. Publishers, broadcasters, printers <u>,</u> or other persons insofar
16	as an unlawful practice as defined in Section 753 of this title
17	involves information that has been disseminated or reproduced on
18	behalf of others without knowledge that it is an unlawful practice;
19	2. Actions or transactions <del>regulated</del> required or authorized
20	under <u>specific</u> laws <u>or regulations</u> administered by the Corporation
21	Commission or any other regulatory body or officer acting under
22	statutory authority of this state or the United States, or to acts
23	done by retailers or other persons acting in good faith on the basis

1	of information or matter supplied by others and without knowledge of
2	the deceptive character of such information or matter; and
3	3. The collection of monies denominated as gross receipts tax
4	on mixed beverages, sales tax or use tax, or asserted injuries or
5	damages that are monies that have been collected as, or denominated
6	as, gross receipts tax on mixed beverages, sales tax or use tax, and
7	which have been remitted to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or other
8	governmental taxing authority.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
