9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
10	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 335 of Title 61, unless there is
12	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
13	A. Any person may forage for nuts and edible plants or fungi on
14	state-owned or state-managed property for personal use and not for
15	resale except when such nuts and other edible plants or fungi are:
16	1. From crops certified by the Oklahoma Agricultural Experiment
17	Station system or the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension Service of the
18	Oklahoma State University Division of Agricultural Sciences and
19	Natural Resources, as provided in Section 8-33 of Title 2 of the
20	Oklahoma Statutes;
21	2. Located on state-owned or University-owned test or research
22	farms;
23	3. On property otherwise restricted for access by state or
24	federal law; or

4. From plants that are threatened or endangered.

B. 1. Any person foraging pursuant to this section on a state
or federal wildlife refuge or Wildlife Management Area shall limit
his or her foraging to days and times authorized by the Oklahoma
Wildlife Conservation Commission.

6 2. The Commission shall promulgate all rules necessary to7 implement the provisions of this section.

C. As used in this section:

9 1. "State-owned or state-managed property" means property owned 10 or managed by an agency, municipality, or political subdivision of 11 this state, unless otherwise stated in subsection A of this section;

2. "Edible plant or fungus" means a plant or fungus commonly
 found in the wild, which is edible to humans in part or in its
 entirety and may require cooking to make safe for consumption; and

15 3. "Nut" means a dry fruit that has a single seed, a hard 16 shell, and a protective husk.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
