5	An Act relating to Oklahoma Today Magazine; amending 74 O.S. 2021, Section 2237, which relates to the
6	creation of the Oklahoma Today Magazine Division; allowing the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
7	Department to distribute magazine by electronic means; updating statutory language; updating
8	statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021, Section 2237, is
12	amended to read as follows:
13	Section 2237. A. There is hereby created within the Oklahoma
14	Tourism and Recreation Department, the "Oklahoma Today Magazine"
15	Division. The Division shall be responsible for the publication of
16	the "Oklahoma Today Magazine" a minimum of six times per year.
17	B. "Oklahoma Today Magazine" is hereby authorized to sell
18	advertising. All advertising shall be approved by the appropriate
19	division director prior to acceptance for publication.
20	C. In addition to a regular salary, any employee of the
21	"Oklahoma Today Magazine" who obtains advertising, bulk
22	subscription, newsstand, or ancillary product sales, for "Oklahoma
23	Today Magazine", at the discretion of the Executive Director of the
24	Department, may be awarded additional compensation in the form of a

The commission shall not exceed twenty-five percent (25%), with the commission percentage to be determined by the Executive Director. In no case shall the additional compensation, when combined with the salary of the employee, exceed ninety-five percent (95%) of the salary of the Executive Director. Commission payments shall be paid monthly, based on collected revenues from sales by the employee.

D. The sale of advertising and negotiation of rates for the
advertising shall not be subject to The the Oklahoma Central
Purchasing Act of 1974 or the Administrative Procedures Act.

E. "Oklahoma Today Magazine" articles, and photographs produced by or for "Oklahoma Today Magazine", shall be available for public inspection during Department business hours. The Department shall not be required to provide copies or allow copying of the magazine, articles, or photographs other than as the Department provides copies of "Oklahoma Today Magazine" for newsstand and subscription sales.

18 <u>F. The Department may deliver copies of "Oklahoma Today</u> 19 <u>Magazine" by electronic means through the Department's subscription</u> 20 <u>sales.</u>
