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7	An Act relating to the State Election Board; amending 26 O.S. 2021, Sections 2-101, 2-101.1, 2-101.2, 2-
8	101.3, 2-101.6, and 2-101.7, which relate to the number of members, appointment of members, filling of
9	vacancies, salary of the Secretary of the State Election Board, and terms of officers; modifying
10	number of Board members after certain time; modifying appointment authority for members; directing
11	membership appointments; establishing quorum and voting requirements; requiring certain notarized
12	lists be provided to the Governor; defining term; providing timeline of appointments; directing manner
13	to fill vacancies; clarifying language; modifying appointing authority of the Secretary of the State
14	Election Board; requiring Senate confirmation; authorizing assistant secretary to assume duties upon
15	certain vacancy; directing manner to fill vacancy; requiring Board to establish salary for Secretary;
16	setting certain date for meeting; updating statutory language; making language gender neutral; repealing
17	26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.5, which relates to chair and vice chair of State Election Board; and providing
18	an effective date.
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21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
22	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101, is
23	amended to read as follows:

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1	Section 2-101. The A. Until July 1, 2027, the State Election
2	Board shall be composed of three (3) members and two (2) alternate
3	members, each of whom shall be appointed by the Governor upon advice
4	and consent of the Senate. An alternate shall serve on the State
5	Election Board at any meeting that a member for whom the person is
6	an alternate is unable to attend. Any person serving as a member or
7	alternate member of the State Election Board on the effective date
8	of this act shall continue to serve in his or her position until
9	July 1, 2027.
10	B. Beginning July 1, 2027, the State Election Board shall be
11	composed of five (5) members, each of whom shall be appointed
12	pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-101.1 of this title.
13	SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.1, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 2-101.1. A. Beginning July 1, 2027, the State Election
16	Board shall consist of the following members:
17	1. One member who is a registered voter of this state appointed
18	by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;
19	2. One member who is a registered voter of this state appointed
20	by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and
21	3. Three members appointed by the Governor, subject to the
22	advice and consent of the Senate, as follows:
23	a. one member from the list provided pursuant to
24	subsection C of this section who is a registered voter

1	of the political party with the largest number of
2	registered voters in this state based on the latest
3	January 15 voter registration report,
4	b. one member from the list provided pursuant to
5	subsection C of this section who is a registered voter
6	of the political party with the second largest number
7	of registered voters in this state based on the latest
8	January 15 voter registration report, and
9	<u>c.</u> one member who is a registered voter of this state but
10	who is not a registered voter of either of the two
11	political parties with the largest number of
12	registered voters in this state.
13	B. A majority of the State Election Board shall constitute a
14	quorum, and action taken by a majority of members voting at any
15	meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the action of the
16	Board.
17	<u>C. 1.</u> No later than March 1, 2015 January 31, 2027, and every
18	four (4) years thereafter, the state central committee of the
19	recognized political party parties having the largest and second
20	largest number of registered voters, based upon the latest January
21	15 registration report, shall submit to the Governor a list of ten
22	(10) nominees for membership on the State Election Board, and the
23	state central committee of the political party having the second
24	largest number of registered voters, based upon the latest January

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1	15 registration report, shall submit to the Governor a list of ten
2	(10) nominees for membership on the State Election Board. The list
3	of nominees shall be signed by a majority of the members of the
4	state central committee, whose signatures shall be notarized by a
5	notary public.
6	The Governor shall be confined to the lists of names submitted
7	by each party and shall appoint two (2) members and one (1)
8	alternate member of the State Election Board from one political
9	party and one (1) member and one (1) alternate member of the State
10	Election Board from the other political party.
11	2. For the purposes of this title, a political party's state
12	central committee shall consist of the party's chair, vice chair,
13	national committeeman and national committeewoman, or the equivalent
14	position under the party's rules.
15	3. Appointments shall be made by the Governor and submitted to
16	the Senate no later than March 15, 2015 March 1, 2027, and every
17	four (4) years thereafter. Provided, for appointments to be made in
18	2011, such submissions shall be provided to the Governor within five
19	(5) business days of the effective date of this act and such
20	appointments shall be made by the Governor within ten (10) business
21	days of the effective date of this act.
22	4. Appointments shall be made by the President Pro Tempore of
23	the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later
24	than June 1, 2027, and every four (4) years thereafter.

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the manner described in this section shall begin on July 1, 2027,
and shall be for a period of four (4) years. Provided, a member
whose term has expired shall continue to serve until a successor is
lawfully appointed and confirmed, if applicable.

6 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.2, is 7 amended to read as follows:

Section 2-101.2. In the event of a vacancy of a State Election 8 9 Board member created by death or, removal, change of political party 10 affiliation, resignation, or any other reason provided by law, the vacancy shall be filled within thirty (30) days in the same manner 11 12 as the member was appointed. If the Governor was the appointing authority, he or she shall, within thirty (30) days after such 13 vacancy occurs, appoint, upon with the advice and consent of the 14 Senate, a member of the same party to fill the unexpired term from a 15 list of five (5) nominees submitted by the party's state central 16 committee within fifteen (15) days after said the vacancy occurs. 17 If the vacancy occurs for the member who is not affiliated with 18 either of the two political parties with the largest number of 19 registered voters in this state, the Governor shall make the 20 appointment, with the advice and consent of the Senate, from the 21 registered voters in this state. 22 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.3, is 23 amended to read as follows: 24

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1 Section 2-101.3. Should If a state central committee fail fails 2 to submit nominees in the manner and within the period prescribed, the Governor shall make his the appointment from within the ranks of 3 4 said the party. 5 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.6, is amended to read as follows: 6 Section 2-101.6. The A. 1. Until January 1, 2026, the 7 Secretary of the Senate shall serve as Secretary of the State 8 9 Election Board at a salary established annually by the Legislature. 10 However, the On January 1, 2026, the position of Secretary of the 11 State Election Board shall be vacant. To fill such vacancy, a 12 person shall be appointed by the State Election Board with the advice and consent of the Senate to serve the remainder of the term 13 vacated pursuant to this subsection. 14 2. Beginning on January 1, 2027, and every four (4) years 15 thereafter, the Secretary of the State Election Board shall be 16 appointed by the State Election Board with the advice and consent of 17 the Senate for a term of four (4) years. 18 B. 1. In the event of a vacancy in the position of the 19 20 Secretary of the State Election Board, the assistant secretary of the State Election Board employed by the Secretary as authorized 21 pursuant to Section 2-107 of this title shall serve as Acting 22 Secretary and shall perform the duties of the Secretary until the 23 vacancy is filled in the manner provided by this section. 24

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1	2. To fill a vacancy in the position of the Secretary of the
2	State Election Board, a person shall be appointed by the State
3	Election Board with the advice and consent of the Senate.
4	<u>C. The</u> Secretary <u>of the State Election Board</u> shall not be a
5	member of the State Election Board. <u>Beginning on January 1, 2026,</u>
6	the salary of the Secretary shall be established by the Board.
7	SECTION 6. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.7, is
8	amended to read as follows:
9	Section 2-101.7. On the first Monday in April, 1983 <u>No later</u>
10	than July 15, 2027, and every four (4) years thereafter, the State
11	Election Board shall meet upon the call of the Secretary <u>of the</u>
12	State Election Board to seat newly appointed board members and to
13	elect a Chairman and Vice Chairman <u>chair and vice chair</u> . Terms of
14	the Chairman, Vice Chairman and member shall begin at that time.
15	SECTION 7. REPEALER 26 O.S. 2021, Section 2-101.5, is
16	hereby repealed.
17	SECTION 8. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
