14	A. As used in this section, the terms "flag", "standard",
15	"colors", or "ensign" of the United States shall have the same
16	meaning as used in subsection C of Section 372 of Title 21 of the
17	Oklahoma Statutes.
18	B. Any person who takes down or removes the flag, standard,
19	colors, or ensign of the United States of America on public property
20	or private property owned by another person or entity without
21	permission and puts up the flag, standard, colors, or ensign of any
22	other entity shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony
23	punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Thousand Dollars
24	(\$3,000.00), imprisonment in the custody of the Department of

Corrections for not more than three (3) years, or by both such fine
