11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:		
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2021, Section 896.1, is		
13	amended to read as follows:		
14	Section 896.1. A. At least thirty (30) days after the approval		
15	for a vote on a bond or other evidence of indebtedness to be issued		
16	by the local government entities described in subsection C of this		
17	section, the governing board of such entity shall cause to be		
18	published on that local government website:		
19	1. A description of the projects or assets that will be		
20	acquired, improved or repaired with the proceeds from the issuance		
21	of the bonds;		
22	2. A description of any unpaid or unfinished bond approved by		
23	the voters of that jurisdiction preceding the date of the vote on		
24	the bonds to be issued; and		

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3. A detailed description of the use of the previous bond
proceeds. If the bond proceeds were used to acquire or improve real
property, the description shall include a physical address using a
street number or some other method by which the location of the
property can be identified.

If the local government entity does not have a website, then 6 в. it shall make the information accessible through some other method 7 using the Internet to persons who reside in the geographic area of 8 9 the local government entity. Should there be no reasonable method as described in this section, the entity shall cause the information 10 to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation 11 12 in the geographic area in which the voters of the local government 13 jurisdiction reside.

The provisions of subsection A of this section shall be С. 14 applicable to any bond or other evidence of indebtedness the 15 repayment of which requires either a sinking fund millage rate 16 pursuant to Section 26 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, or 17 bonds issued pursuant to the authority of Section 35 of Article X of 18 the Oklahoma Constitution or pursuant to any provisions contained in 19 any other provision of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution to the 20 extent not otherwise specifically identified in this section, which 21 shall include: 22

23 1. Counties;

24 2. Cities;

1	3.	Towns;
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- 2 4. Common school districts;
- 3 5. Career technology districts;
- 4 6. Emergency Medical Service Districts; and
- 5 7. Solid waste management districts.

The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to 6 D. 7 include obligations issued by a trust organized pursuant to the provisions of Section 176 et seq. of Title 60 of the Oklahoma 8 9 Statutes for the benefit of a local government entity described in subsection C of this section, whereby the proceeds of such 10 11 obligations were expended by the local government entity for 12 projects, assets, or property described in subsection A of this 13 section.

E. Any local government entity that fails to comply with the 14 provisions of this section shall not issue any bonds or other 15 obligations until the entity comes into compliance with the 16 17 provisions of this section.
