D. The State Purchasing Director may authorize the use of a
state purchase card for acquisitions within the following
parameters:

- 1. No limit on the amount of the transaction for the following:
 a. purchases from statewide contracts and from contracts
 awarded by the State Purchasing Director for the
 benefit of a state agency,
- 10 b. utilities,
- 11 c. interagency payments,
- d. emergency acquisitions; provided, requirements to
 establish an emergency pursuant to Section 5 of this
 act or other applicable statute or rule have been met,
 and
- e. professional services as defined in Section 803 of
 Title 18 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

18 2. For any other transaction with a state purchase card, the 19 transaction shall not exceed the greater of Five Thousand Dollars 20 (\$5,000.00) or the limit determined by the State Purchasing 21 Director, not to exceed the fair and reasonable acquisition 22 threshold amount.

E. The State Purchasing Director may authorize personnel of theDepartment of Commerce, upon a finding by the Secretary of Commerce

1 that such personnel have a legitimate need therefore, to utilize a state purchase card for acquisitions for programs, functions or 2 services essential to the mission of the agency while traveling on 3 Department of Commerce business in foreign locations with 4 5 transaction limits not to exceed Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00). The purchase cardholders are required to sign a 6 purchase card agreement prior to becoming a cardholder and to attend 7 purchase card procedure training. The Department of Commerce will 8 9 conduct quarterly internal auditing on all purchase card transactions associated with business and travel in foreign 10 locations. 11 F. Any political subdivision participating in the state 12 purchase card program may issue a solicitation pursuant to the 13 provisions Section 85.7 of this title for the acquisition of a 14 15 purchase card.
