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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to child care; requiring certain  
8 child care facilities to ensure absence of certain  
9 content in specified materials; making noncompliant  
10 child care facilities ineligible for certain funding;  
11 authorizing promulgation of rules; providing for  
12 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 405.6 of Title 10, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. A child care facility that receives funding through the  
18 Department of Human Services including, but not limited to, through  
19 the child care subsidy program shall ensure that no print or  
20 nonprint materials or multimedia resources located on the premises  
21 of the facility contain any content related to sexual orientation or  
22 gender identity.

23 B. A child care facility found by the Department to be in  
24 violation of subsection A of this section after complaint and  
25 investigation under Section 406 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes

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shall be ineligible for the child care subsidy program and any other funding through the Department until such facility is determined to be in compliance by the Department.

C. The Director of Human Services may promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.

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
