SENATE BILL 502

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishment; defining term; creating felony offense; providing for penalty; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 761 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. "Cannibalism" means to willingly ingest the flesh, blood, or tissue of a human being.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person to commit cannibalism. Any person who violates the provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed fourteen (14) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
