14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified	
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-161.1 of Title 70, unless	
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:	
17	A. Before annual enrollment of a student in a public school	
18	district, the school shall provide information to the parent or	
19	guardian who is enrolling the student concerning all the education	
20	options available to students within this state, including:	
21	1. The education options under the Education Open Transfer Act,	
22	including:	
23	a. the ability for Oklahoma students to transfer from

district pursuant to Sections 8-101.2, 8-103, 8-103.1, 8-103.2, 8-113 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and

- b. the ability for Oklahoma students to transfer to different school sites within their resident school district pursuant to Section 8-114 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 2. The education opportunities available under the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax Credit Act, including:
  - a. the Oklahoma Parental Choice Tax Credit for other means of education pursuant to Sections 10-105 and 28-101 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and
  - b. the Oklahoma School Choice Tax Credit for private school tuition and fees pursuant to Section 28-101 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 3. The education opportunities available under the Oklahoma Charter Schools Act, including:
  - a. the availability of statewide virtual charter school enrollment within the state, and
  - b. the existence of physical charter schools within the school district and all directly adjacent school district boundaries; and

4. The education opportunities available under the Lindsey
Nicole Henry Scholarship for Students with Disabilities Program
pursuant to Section 13-101.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

- B. This information shall be posted on the school district website throughout the year, updated yearly as new education options arise, and be readily available in school office premises for distribution to parents inquiring about their education options.
- C. The State Department of Education shall develop a document including all information required by this section that applies to all public school students within the state for the dissemination of information required by this section and shall make it available to school districts through its website or other means necessary.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
