Subject to receipt of any necessary federal approval for the Food is Medicine Initiative under Section 3 of this act, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall implement a financial incentive for contracted entities who improve health outcomes of covered members through nutrition services provided under the initiative.

- NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5009.7 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall seek any necessary Α. federal approval to expand covered nutrition services under the state Medicaid program for the purpose of implementing a Food is Medicine Initiative.
- The Food is Medicine Initiative shall be designed to improve health outcomes for Medicaid members through nutrition services and reduce the need for medical care.
- Nutrition services covered under the Food is Medicine Initiative may include, but are not limited to:
 - 1. Case management;
 - 2. Nutrition counseling;
 - 3. Meals or pantry stocking;
 - 4. Nutrition prescriptions; and
 - 5. Grocery provisions.
