SENATE BILL 905 By: Murdock

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to controlled dangerous substances; ordering a legislative referendum pursuant to the Oklahoma Constitution; creating felony offense; providing penalty; providing for codification; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution, there is hereby ordered the following legislative referendum which shall be filed with the Secretary of State and addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to the people for their approval or rejection at the next General Election.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-441 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person who unlawfully possesses a controlled dangerous substance while also in possession of a firearm shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not more than five (5) years.
