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14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15	1ST SESSION OF THE 60TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the repeal of Section 50 of Article V, Sections 6, 7, 8, 8A, 8B, 8C,
19	8D, 8E, 8F, 9, 9A, 9B, 9C, 9D, 10, 10A, 10B, 11, 12A, 22, and 22A of
20	Article X, and Sections 1 and 2 of Article XII-A of the Oklahoma
21	Constitution, effective January 1, 2030, and the following proposed
22	amendment to Section 21 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution to
23	read as follows:

1 Section 21. A. There shall be a State Board of Equalization 2 consisting of the Governor, State Auditor, State Treasurer, 3 Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, State Inspector and Examiner 4 and President of the Board of Agriculture. The duty of said Board 5 shall be to adjust and equalize the valuation of real and personal 6 property of the several counties in the state, and it shall perform 7 such other duties as may be prescribed by law, and they shall assess 8 all railroad and public service corporation property.

9 Should the Offices of State Examiner and Inspector and State в. 10 Auditor be consolidated in the Office of State Auditor and 11 Inspector, the State Auditor shall be replaced as a member of the 12 State Board of Equalization by the State Auditor and Inspector and 13 the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall be added as a member 14 thereof. Should the offices not be so consolidated, the membership 15 shall remain the same as provided in subsection A of this section 16 and the Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not be added to 17 the membership.
