12	from highways, roads, streets, and bridges to home foundations,
13	office walls, glass for all uses, and fracking sand that powers
14	Oklahoma's oil and natural gas industry; and
15	WHEREAS, all those critical economic outcomes begin with the
16	production and use of aggregates - the rock, sand, gravel, and
17	gypsum that lays the foundation for all infrastructure; and
18	WHEREAS, aggregates in Oklahoma is a nearly \$1 billion industry,
19	supporting 8,450 jobs and \$457 million in annual employee
20	compensation, paying 20% higher-than-average Oklahoma wages; and
21	WHEREAS, Oklahoma aggregates are the primary construction
22	material used by the Department of Transportation, Oklahoma Turnpike
23	Authority, and county, city, and tribal governments, as well as real
24 2 -	estate developers and homebuilders.
