22	1. An attorney of his or her choice or, if he or she has no
23	funds to pay for an attorney of his or her choice, the public
24	defender, or other attorney assigned by the court to assist

1	indigents, whose telephone number shall be posted within the city or
2	county jail facility;
3	2. A bail bondsman; and
4	3. A relative or other person chosen by the arrested person.
5	The telephone calls shall be provided immediately upon request, or

7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
