1 Section 2 of this act and shall be subject to appropriation by the 2 Legislature. SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 3 4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5002 of Title 62, unless there 5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 6 There is hereby created within the General Revenue Fund of the 7 State Treasury the "Federal Funds Holding Account". Unless federal law prohibits or restricts it, all funds authorized or required to be paid to the State of Oklahoma by the federal government, its 10 agencies, instrumentalities or other federal governmental entity 11 shall be deposited or transferred to the credit of the Federal Funds 12 Holding Account and shall be subject to appropriation by the 13 Legislature. 14 SECTION 3. SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
