6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to summer nutrition; stating purpose  
8 of act; requiring the Oklahoma Department of Human  
9 Services to administer the Summer Electronic Benefit  
10 Transfer for Children program; requiring  
11 collaboration with the State Department of Education  
12 in implementing the program; providing for  
13 codification; providing an effective date; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-119.2 of Title 70, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The purpose of this section is to establish the State of  
20 Oklahoma's participation in the federal Summer Electronic Benefit  
21 Transfer for Children (Summer EBT) program to provide supplemental  
22 nutrition assistance to eligible children during the summer months  
23 when school is not in session beginning on June 1, 2026, and beyond.

24 B. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services (OKDHS) shall  
administer the Summer EBT Program in accordance with federal  
regulations and guidelines.

1 C. The Department of Human Services shall work with the State  
2 Department of Education to determine eligibility of children and  
3 reduce administrative burden on qualifying families for the Summer  
4 EBT program established pursuant to the federal Consolidated  
5 Appropriations Act, 2023.

6 D. The Department of Human Services and the State Department of  
7 Education shall share all data determined by each Department to be  
8 necessary to implement and administer the Summer EBT program  
9 statewide.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2025.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
