NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-702.1 of Title 63, unless 15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 No hospital license shall be transferred from its current 17 address to an address greater than fifteen (15) miles away, if the 18 hospital license is located in a community with a population of 19 fewer than thirty thousand (30,000) residents, according to the 20 latest Federal Decennial Census. If a hospital facility announces a 21 closure, before the closure of the facility, a mediator shall be 22 appointed. The city in which the hospital is located shall also 23 appoint a mediator if the hospital is within city limits, if not,

then the county shall appoint a mediator. The two mediators shall

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    appoint a mutually agreed-upon third mediator. The three mediators
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    shall agree upon a sales price for the hospital license, if the
    hospital and the municipality cannot agree without mediation. The
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    hospital license shall be purchased and transferred to the city or
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    county if the city or county is willing to pay the agreed-upon
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    purchase price set forth by the mediators.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
