20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified							
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 342.23 of Title 74, unless there							
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:							
23	A. There is hereby created a grant program to support training							
24	needs of volunteer firefighters in Oklahoma. The program shall							

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assist volunteer firefighters to receive up to ten (10) hours in training a year from programs approved by the State Fire Marshall or by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry's Forestry Division.

B. The State Fire Marshall shall create an application system for volunteer firefighters to apply for the grant assistance. The State Fire Marshall may promulgate rules for the grant program.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 342.24 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Fire Marshall to be designated the "Oklahoma Volunteer Firefighter Support Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Fire Marshall from appropriations, donations, grants, or other sources of funding specifically designated for deposit to the Oklahoma Volunteer Firefighter Support Revolving Fund. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State Fire Marshall for the purpose of this act. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
