16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article VI of the

21	$\underline{A}$ . No person shall be eligible to the office of Governor,
22	Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, State Auditor and

    THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

    This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends Section 3
20
    of Article 6. The Oklahoma Constitution currently requires that

    candidates running for the office of Superintendent of Public

    Instruction be at least thirty-one (31) years old and be qualified
23
    to register to vote for at least ten (10) years. This measure adds
24
    two (2) qualifications for candidates running for the office of

    candidates to have completed public school administrator
