HB1007, as introduced, establishes that identification cards issued by schools, universities or other education institutions does not constitute valid proof of identity for voting purposes.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1007 prohibits the use of photo identification issued by colleges or universities as proof of identity for voting. Implementation of the measure will require an updated training curriculum for precinct officials, and potential updates to some signage and other informational materials. After communication with the Oklahoma State Election Board, implementation of the measure is anticipated to carry a one-time cost of \$25,000 or less.
