The policy recommendation amendment to HB 1010 adds that subsections I and J don't apply if the state central committee provides proof that either the second-place candidate endorsed another or no candidate secured enough delegates for the nomination on the first ballot.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The policy recommendation amendment to HB 1010 does not materially alter the fiscal impact statement for the measure. Based on the current estimated cost for a statewide primary election of approximately \$2,200,000, implementation of the measure may result in a positive fiscal impact to the State Election Board of \$2.2 million or less. Note that this is a range estimate, where a \$0 positive impact is anticipated when such circumstances do not occur
