**Research Analysis**

HB1027, as introduced, is a technical clean-up bill for the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System (OLERS). The measure updates the definition of *member* to include university police officers and Grand River Dam Authority lake patrolmen and dispatchers, which were added to the system in 2001 and 2003, respectively. The bill also clarifies the price to purchase service credit while a member is on temporary disability.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1027 provides IRS technical and administrative corrections to the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Retirement System (OLERS). Officials from OLERS confirmed the statutory updates have no actuarial impact on the Retirement System, and therefore, no direct fiscal implications for the state.
