Research Analysis

HB 1043 provides that a driver license issued by another state exclusively to undocumented immigrants is invalid in the state of Oklahoma. Law enforcement is required to issue a citation for operation of a motor vehicle without a license. All law enforcement agencies are required to maintain on their website a list of out-of-state classes of driver licenses that are invalid in Oklahoma.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1043 declares that certain licenses related to undocumented immigrants are invalid in Oklahoma. In addition, the measure mandates citations for such licenses in certain circumstances. The measure does not mandate any action or expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
