**Research Analysis**

HB 1046, as introduced, creates the Oklahoma Spay and Neuter Grant Program which will be overseen and carried out by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (ODAFF). Grants will be awarded by ODAFF based on the recommendation of the Oklahoma Spay and Neuter Grant Program Advisory Board, the membership and duties of which is determined in the measure. Grants may be sought by local governments or animal welfare organizations. The measure provides criteria for what constitutes a competitive grant proposal as well as criterion for the which the Department will evaluate grant proposals. The measure also appropriates to ODAFF from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury the sum of \$0 or so much thereof may be necessary to implement the program.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1046 creates the Oklahoma Spay and Neuter Grant Program within the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (ODAFF). Currently, ODAFF does not believe this program would result in any additional administrative cost for the agency. This measure also creates a revolving fund for the program but not does appropriate any money to the fund; therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations for the state.
