HB1068, as introduced, prohibits any state governmental entity, including public trusts, from entering into an agreement with another entity if the entity prohibits the state from disclosing any information about state tax incentives received by the entity. Trade secrets and proprietary information provided to the state from a contracting entity is exempt from disclosure.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1068 prohibits state or local government entities from entering into certain agreements. The measure encourages disclosure of terms of agreements with certain entities whose benefits are provided through the use of state taxes. The measure is related to improper business practices and does not mandate any expenditure by a state agency. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
