The proposed committee substitute to HB 1076 establishes the Food Truck Freedom Act, providing clear guidelines for the regulation of mobile food vendors. The State Commissioner of Health is authorized to promulgate rules to ensure compliance between local authorities and mobile food vendors. The measure clarifies regulatory standards and is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the state budget.
