**Research Analysis**

HB 1086, as introduced, modifies multiple provisions of law related to a school district's general fund carryover allowance. The measure requires gifts, grants, or donations that a school put in its general fund to be included in the carryover calculation. The measure also reduces the allowable carryover percentages.

Further, the measure allows a district to carryover up to 50 percent of its gross production revenue in addition to any other allowable general fund carryover. The district shall not be penalized for exceeding carryover amounts if the penalty would occur because of the gross production revenue portion carried over.

Lastly, the measure removes a calculation used to determine the weighted membership for students using online instruction from districts where they are not a resident.
