**Research Analysis**

HB 1095 would allow the governing body of a city or town to authorize the concealed carry of handguns into any structure, building, or office space except courthouses, courtrooms, prison, jail, detention facilities or other facilities used to hold prisoners. The measure allows elected municipal officials and employees designated by the city manager and approved by the city council to carry a concealed handgun when acting in the performance of their official duties if the person is in possession of a valid handgun license.
