HB1120, as introduced, establishes state control over election-related decisions by requiring legislative oversight for the implementation of federal directives and the acceptance of federal funds. It introduces accountability measures, including mandatory notifications, annual financial disclosures, and penalties for non-compliance, aiming to maintain state sovereignty in election administration.
